Looking ahead

- ⇒ With two bank holidays on 1st and 8th May, we have two relatively short school weeks, at the end of which Year 11 and 13 students will be starting examination leave. The last normal school day for our Year 13s will be on Thursday 11th May and for Year 11 on Friday 12th. A programme of events is currently being planned both days and will be sent to students in due course.
- ⇒ On *Tuesday 9th May*, some *Year 12 and Year 13 English students* will be involved in a "Knowledge is Power" conference here at LGS. We will host guest speakers from Reading University who will deliver a lectures on topics covered in the Sixth Form course. Some Year 11 students who have shown an interest in studying English in the Sixth Form will also attend for part of the day.
- ⇒ On Friday 12th May, 80 Year 10s will take part in a Duke of Edinburgh's Silver Award training day here at LGS. The day will be run by an external provider and will involve navigation, camp craft, tent building and food preparation.
- ⇒ **Year 11, 12 and 13 students** studying GCSE, AS and A Level **French or German** will have their Modern Foreign Languages speaking exams during the period from 9th to 12th May.

Coronation of HM King Charles III

Saturday 6th May sees the Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III. We have not seen a coronation ceremony is this country for 70 years, and the UK is one of the few remaining countries to hold such an event.
