The successful candidate would be expected to teach Chemistry across a range of classes in Years 9-11 and to contribute to the teaching of the Year 7/8 Science course. Chemistry is a popular choice for students in the Sixth Form and the opportunity to teach A Level is available for a suitably qualified and/or experienced candidate. Applications from newly qualified teachers with an appropriate academic background are welcome. The ability to teach another science subject, particularly Physics, may also be advantageous.
