Candidates should have a track record of successful Sixth Form teaching and should have the academic background and knowledge to teach Economics to highly motivated and aspirational students. The ability to teach an additional subject at A Level would be welcome and a responsibility allowance as Teacher in Charge may be available for a suitably experienced candidate.

Langley Grammar School is a very popular co-educational 11-18 selective school with academy status, located within easy reach of Langley station and the M4. We have approximately 1140 students, over 320 of whom are in the Sixth Form; the school is heavily over-subscribed and draws students from a wide geographical area. We are a National Teaching School with a record of innovative practice and extensive outreach and support work in local primary and secondary schools. In recent years a major building programme has included excellent sports facilities and a distinctive Sixth Form Centre. The school was last inspected in 2007, and was graded outstanding in all categories.
