Content First</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do you build on prior knowledge & skills? • Are your instructions crystal clear? • Is there enough support & challenge? • Do students know their learning objectives? • Do students know where they have come from and where they are going to? (Curriculum Map) • Do they know what a good one looks/sounds like? 	<p>2. Technological Literacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can you organise work on OneDrive? • Can you share worksheets and resources? • Can you set up shared folders? • Can you create videos and audio instruction? • Can you use Teams to effectively instruct a class? • Can you use ClassCharts to track engagement? • Can you create authentic assessments?

Motivation through Collaboration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are you creating group tasks? • Do students work in isolation or do they share ideas and work with each other? • Can you plan and set up collaborative activities/projects? • Can you use Teams to effectively facilitate a class discussion? 	<p>4. Independence & Reflection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do students have checklists? • Do students have timelines? • Do students reflect at key points? • Do students improve their own and others work? • Do students feedback on distance learning methods used?

Variety</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do you ask students to read text and complete worksheets? • Are you setting work or 'cover work'? • Do you plan for a variety of learning activities? • Do your students enjoy the work? • Do your learning activities lead into one another? • Have you distinguished between the 5 EEF Home Learning Approaches? • Is there a level of differentiation embedded into the work set?
