When do students get iPads

Students use iPads to support learning from Yr 8 upwards .

Roll-out to Year 7 in late summer term

Parent-funded through purchase or lease – or use one you already have.

What do we have to pay for?

- Uniform and equipment
- Visits and other activities
- Occasional subject expenses
- iPad provision (end of Year 7)
- Locker rental (Year 8 upwards)
- Individual music lessons (*optional*)

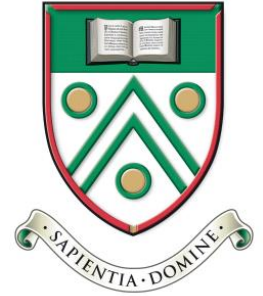

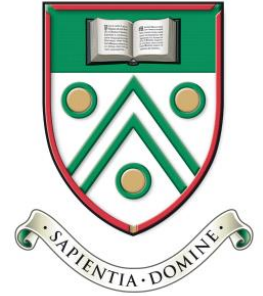
