






Pastoral structure - phases

What this does:

Building project

- £18 million investment
- Funded by DfE (£14m), Slough Borough Council (£3.5m) and the school (£0.5m)
- 3 phases
 - New teaching block completion Feb 2020
 Demolition of old buildings Mar to Jul 2020
 New main block completion June 2021

Project phasing



Phase 1	Feb 2019	Set up contractors' compound and access road to back of school. Start building new 2-storey teaching block on the current hard court area Set up temporary accommodation in Nov/Dec 2019
Phase 2	Feb 2020	Move subject teaching to new block. Move into temporary accommodation on remaining hard courts for dining room, kitchen, library, staff and admin offices etc
	March 2020	Start demolishing the old 1956 buildings
	July 2020	Start building new 2-storey ' Front of House' block Lay new hard courts at front of school Complete site landscaping
Phase 3	July 2021	Move from temporary accommodation into new FOH block Reinstate hard courts at rear of school

Phase 1 – new teaching block

Ground floor	Design Technology workshop and graphics rooms Art textiles room and 3D Art room with kiln Three computing/ICT rooms Small meeting rooms, offices and staff work area.
First floor	Three general art rooms, one with a photographic darkroom Six Computing/ICT rooms Two general classrooms New server room and IT technicians office Offices and staff work area
Second floor	Ten new science laboratories Science preparation and storage area








Next steps
