Admission to Year 7 in September 2026

Frequently Asked Questions regarding Admission Test Results.

PLEASE NOTE: The schools will not be able to give any further information about test results other than the individual test score that you have received online.

How do I access my child's 11+ examination results?
Results are available online at https://slough.applicaa.com/entry2026 You will need the email used at time of registration and the password you created. To see the result – please click on the test results icon.
What is the eligibility mark for admission to Year 7 in September 2026?
A score of 111 or greater means that a pupil is <i>eligible to be considered</i> for a grammar school place if they apply.
My child has achieved a score of 111 or above – will they be offered a place?
If a grammar school is oversubscribed, i.e. has more applicants than it has places available, places will be offered according to the criteria set out in the individual school's admissions policy. <i>A score of 111 in itself is therefore not a guarantee of a place.</i>
How many candidates sat the 2025 entrance test for the Slough Consortium for entry in September 2026
Approximately 4814 sat the test at a Slough Consortium grammar school.
What was the range of standardised scores in the 2025 entrance test for September 2026 entry?
GL, the test providers have advised that this year the range of average standardised scores is 70 - 140.
For 2025 entry, what was the lowest mark achieved by a candidate who was offered a place at one of the Slough Consortium schools?

When must I submit my Common Application Form?
The CAF deadline is 31 st October 2025. If there are exceptional circumstances that mean you wish to change your preferences after this date you must contact your Local Authority.
What are my child's raw scores for the tests?
The Slough Consortium of Grammar schools do not release this information.
Can I see my child's test papers?
It is not possible to see any candidate's test papers. Question books and answer sheets are not in the public domain in order to safeguard the integrity of the test. All documentation remains the property of GL the test providers.

I would like my child's paper remarked – what do I do?
The test provider GL Assessment is responsible for marking the papers. GL Assessment's marking system is accurate and fair, with scanning work compliant with requirements of 99.9% guaranteed reading accuracy and human checking of all responses where the scan is not fully clear. The Slough Consortium <i>does not offer a re-mark service</i> by GL Assessment. Any re-mark service usually offered by the test provider <i>does not apply</i> to the Slough Consortium 11+ process. If you have a query regarding your child's results or appeal process you should, in the first instance, discuss this with the school where your child sat the test, who may advise you on the correct course of action.
When will I know if my child has a place in a Slough Consortium grammar school?
Offers of school places will be made by your local authority on 2nd March 2026.
How do I appeal?
It is not possible to appeal your child's 11+ score. Appeals can only be made against a decision by a school not to admit your child. For this reason, the appeals process only takes place after the national allocation day in March. Information about the appeals process will be provided with the school allocation information, on 2nd March 2026. Specific information about making an appeal to a Slough grammar school will also appear on the Slough Consortium of Grammar schools' websites after 2nd March 2026. There will be no Consortium appeals before March 2026. Please note that any school to which a parent wishes to appeal <u>must</u> be named on the Common Application Form.
What do I need to do now?
Read the Admissions Policy for any of the schools in which you are interested to ensure you are eligible to apply. The Admissions Policies can be found on the websites of each school, which can be accessed using the links below. You should have completed your CAF by 31st October 2025. Please check with your local authority if you wish to make any amendments.
