Workshop Outline

What is this session about:

In this session students will create a digital artefact to share their ideas, worries or questions in response to what they understand, think and know.

Learning Outcomes

- To promote understanding of Earth Day and why it is important to celebrate.
- To create a safe space where students can share their thinking and feelings together.
- To create a digital artefact to share something that is important to them.

Activities

- Create an Earth Day eBook
- Create a Voice Over movie using Google Earth, Screen Record and iMovie.
- Create a digital story to share their ideas in response to the Oliver Jeffers picture book, 'Here We Are'.

Essential Questions

- What is Earth Day?
- Why is Earth day important to learn about?
- How does Earth Day connect to me?
- Why do we need to protect our environment?
- What are the consequences of not protecting the environment?
- Why is sharing our questions, ideas and worries important?
- How does the perspectives of Earth Day change
