Dear Stakeholders

Re: Admissions Policy Consultation – 2027-2028

In line with the School Admissions Code 2021, schools are required to consult on their Admissions Policy at least once every seven years, or sooner if a significant change is being proposed. Langley Grammar School is commencing a consultation on its Admissions Policy for the academic year 2027-2028 due to proposed changes.

As part of this process, the Governing Board is proposing a number of revisions which are summarised below. The proposed changes include:

- Increasing the maximum number of places available for eligible applicants whose permanent home address is within the school's Priority Area 1, from the current number of 100 to 120.
- Giving priority when allocating places, to eligible applicants whose permanent home address in the school's Priority Area 3 who attract Pupil Premium funding over other students in Priority Area 3.
- For in-year admissions, giving priority when allocating places to eligible applicants whose permanent home address in the school's Priority Area 2 who attract Pupil Premium funding over other students in Priority Area 2, and similarly, giving priority to eligible applicants living in the school's Priority Area 3 who attract Pupil Premium funding over other students in Priority Area 3.
- For the admission of external applicants into the Sixth Form, giving priority to children of school staff who have met the entry requirements for admission to Year 12 over other external applicants other than Looked After Children or children who have been previously looked after.

These proposed revisions aim to ensure the policy continues to support access for eligible local applicants and ensures the priority already given to students who attract Pupil Premium funding is consistently applied across the school's Priority Areas for admission.
