Service Pupil Premium

I am writing to inform you that the school receives a small amount of additional funding on behalf of your son/daughter through the Service Pupil Premium (SPP) grant. Your son/ daughter is eligible for the SPP as a child of a service family; this funding is allocated to provide additional pastoral support needed to help service children through the frequent changes of school which are likely for service families and to support a child whose parent may be on deployment.

The Department for Education publishes the following eligibility information about the SPP:

- one of their parents is serving in the regular armed forces
- they have been registered as a 'service child' on the January school census at any point since 2015
- one of their parents died whilst serving in the armed forces and the pupil receives a pension under the Armed Forces Compensation Scheme or the War Pensions Scheme
- students with a parent who is on full commitment as part of the full time reserve service are classed as service children.
